FEASTS OF THE WEEK

Mon 8 Jun St Colman, *bishop who founded a monastery near the Lagan River. Patron of our diocese of Dromore, lived around AD 450–520.*

Tue 9 Jun St Colmcille, *native of Donegal, abbot who founded monasteries in Ireland and began the emigration of Irish monks as missionaries. Secondary patron of Ireland.*

Wed 10 Jun St Ephrem, *Syrian deacon, renowned for his learning, poetry, holiness and devotion to Mary. Died 373.*

Thu 11 Jun St Barnabas, *apostle born in Cyprus, convert companion of St Paul on his missionary work.*

Fri 12 Jun Most Sacred Heart of Jesus
Sat 13 Jun Immaculate Heart of Mary; *also Saint Anthony of Padua, Franciscan monk with the gift of preaching. Our church patron.*

TRIATHLON OF PILGRIMAGES
